TexShare Cards: Local Library Systems Policies

Before advising patrons on obtaining a TexShare Card from a local library system, please consider the system's registration policy. In most cases, participating libraries require that a patron be a library card holder for 90-180 days with no fines or fees. If a patron is not already a library card holder at one of these libraries, and is attempting to gain access to UHD materials via TexShare, immediate access will not be possible given the registration requirements.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

Houston Community College System (HCCS)

HCC issues TexShare Cards to students who:

• Have an active HCCS library barcode

*Card privileges are active only for the duration of the semester in which you received the card. You must apply for a new card each semester you are enrolled

Houston Public Library System (HPL)

HPL issues TexShare Cards to patrons who:

- Have had a HPL library card for at least 6 months (180 days)
- Are residents of Houston, TX (ID must have an address with Houston, TX listed)
- Have no outstanding fines

Harris County Public Library System (HCPL)

HCPL issues TexShare Cards to patrons who:

- Have had an HCPL library card for at least 3 months (90 days)
- Have no overdue or lost books
- Have no fines

Fort Bend County Library System (FBCLS)

FBCLS issues TexShare Cards to patrons who:

- Are a Fort Bend County resident and a Fort Bend County Libraries registered cardholder
- Have no overdue items
- Have no fines or fees

*Must present Fort bend County library card and photo ID
